

Goshen School Supply List

Kinder/First/Second Grade:

DO NOT WRITE CHILD'S NAME ON:

- 2 pkgs. of #2 yellow pencils (12 each)
- 6 small glue sticks or 2 lg. glue sticks
- 1 box of tissue (250 count, non-scented)
- 1 bottle of white glue
- 1 pkg of pencil top erasers

WRITE CHILD'S NAME ON THE FOLLOWING:

- 3 spiral notebooks -wide ruled (not kinders)
- 1 folder-peechee style any design
- 1 box of 8 skinny markers
- 1 box of 8 fat markers
- 1 box of 24 Crayola crayons
- 1 pair Fiskar scissors
- 1 set of watercolors with 8 colors
- 1 pencil box
- 1 backpack (*no wheeled backpacks*)
- 1 box colored pencils (optional)
- 1 bottle hand sanitizer (optional)

Fifth/Sixth Grade:

- 3 pkgs. of #2 pencils
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 4 composition notebooks
- 1 ruler
- 3 pkgs. notebook paper
- 2 erasers
- 4 spiral notebooks
- 1 set of watercolors
- 3 boxes of colored pencils
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 box tissues (250 count)
- 2 boxes of skinny markers
- 1 box of fat markers
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 school box
- 1 calculator
- 3 Flair pens
- 1 hand sanitizer

Third/Fourth Grade:

- 2 pkgs. of #2 yellow pencils (at least 48)
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 3-ring binder notebook (NO trappers)
- 1 ruler
- 1 pkg. ring binder tab dividers/5 color tab
- 4 pkgs. Notebook paper (wide line)
- 2 erasers
- 2 spiral notebooks
- 1 set of watercolors
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 pair of Fiskar scissors
- 2 boxes tissues (250 count)
- 1 box of skinny markers
- 1 box of fat markers
- 1 glue
- 1 school box
- Backpack (NO wheeled backpacks)

Seventh/Eighth Grade:

- 2 pkgs. of #2 pencils
- 1 2" 3-ring binder
- 1 ruler (plastic)
- 2 pkgs. Binder tab dividers
- 2 pkgs. notebook paper (college ruled)
- 1 eraser or 3 pkgs. pencil top erasers
- 4 composition notebooks
- 2 spiral notebooks
- 3 boxes of colored pencils
- 1 pair of scissors
- 3 boxes tissues (250 count)
- 2 boxes of skinny markers
- 1 box of fat markers
- 2 glue sticks
- 5 Flair pens
- 1 calculator
- 1 hand sanitizer
